Staffing

Physicians – With a fully-staffed emergency physician team, Capital Emergency Physicians (CEP) has a 20-year stellar track record with St. Mary's. In fact, patient satisfaction with our emergency physicians is consistently in the 99th percentile nationally. Fourteen out of 15 of our emergency physicians are board certified.

Registered Nurses – In addition to friendly, compassionate care, the emergency department nurses are specially trained in emergency medicine, including extensive training in trauma, advanced cardiac life support and pediatric advanced life support. St. Mary's ED is the only ED in town staffed with 100% registered nurses, 39 in total, which means all are nurses are certified to provide exceptional emergency care.
